

Tournament Recaps—Francisco Grande and Ocotillo (Gold/Blue)

The last two weekends found us on the south end of The Valley, first at Francisco Grande and then at Ocotillo on the Gold and Blue nines. Full stat summaries in the table below. Here are some highlights:

- The Thursam boys had a battle for the ages at Ocotillo, with Tyler edging out his dad, Jeff, 72 to 73. Tyler's even-par round featured three birdies, twelve pars and three bogeys, while Jeff ended up one birdie short.
- Tyler's \$159 in winnings from the round was easily the best of the '20-'21 SGL season to-date.
- Steve Hulka has completed his five qualifying rounds and won the Callaway Flight in four of them. He will enter regular league play as a Flight 1 player.
- Al Palange's win at Francisco Grande was his 2nd in a row.
- Prag Shah also has a two-event winning streak.
- Al and Prag join the list of three-time winners in the current season that also includes Elmer Schmidt and Kyle Voda
- Michael Urman's 24 putts at Ocotillo is the lowest in any event this season by two strokes
