GOLF TIP OF THE WEEK

B: Two-Stroke Penalty

In this situation, Player A **only dropped one ball** and then placed a secondary the ball when required to drop.

Player A gets a penalty of two strokes, for a breach of Rule 14.3c(2).

Correct procedure: If Player A had made two drops and both balls had rolled into the red penalty area and then placed a ball where the second drop first touched the ground, Player A would not have received a penalty.
