There are a few events on the horizon and we want to ensure everyone is aware of the exciting upcoming competitions and how they are scored. Let's start with the first one... Wigwam Warriors.

WIGWAM WARRIORS

There are three courses at the Wigwam Golf Resort (Red, Blue and Gold) and we play all 54 holes, which is three rounds, throughout the 2022-2023 season. The entry fee is \$25. Your goal is to post the best net scoring average of the three tournaments but you must play all three courses to win. A tip of the cap to last year's winner, Kyle Voda!

RINGERS!

Similar to Wigwam Warriors, the RINGERS competition involves multiple tournament events. Each year, we pick one course and play it five times throughout the season, and this year's Ringers course is Aguila Golf Club. The cost is \$25 and is the MOST popular game of the season. To win this event, each player is trying to score their best score on each hole after five rounds. Essentially, you get five rounds to get the lowest score on each hole. Payouts go to both low gross and low net scores. There is no sign up deadline and you do NOT need to play all five rounds to compete. TEST YOUR RULES KNOWLEDGE



John is a golfer. John's tee shot heads to the right side of the fairway and comes to rest in the general area near the base of a tree.

John is right-handed and is not able to make a right-handed stroke at the ball but is able to make a reasonable left-handed stroke to advance the ball into the fairway and closer to the putting green. In taking a stance for a left-hand stroke, John's stance is on a cart path in the general area.

John takes free relief from interference by the cart path and then makes a right-handed stroke which comes to rest close to the putting green. What, if any, is the penalty?

ELIGIBILITY

Any current active members of the Saturday Golf League. (Past members must renew SGL membership thru the AGA and have handicap verified by the SGL Handicap Chairman)

FORMAT

1. Individual Stroke Play - All USGA and SGL Local Rules apply including MAS.
2. Flights will be set up using standard SGL requirements.
3. Scoring for both Gross and Net will be done as usual and will be Live during play on Golf Genius.
4. Players will only be able to win either a Gross or Net prize (not both).
5. No side games such as skins, CTP, low putts, etc.
6. There is a maximum of 60 players allowed for this major event.

COST & INSTRUCTIONS

1. Payment for this event is a two-step process. You will be required to enter this event and prepay \$118.26 to the course thru the following link: [Sterling Grove SGL Sign Up](#)
2. You must also pay an additional \$35.00 (\$30 prize pool plus \$5 for administrative fees) either thru your Player Account or thru the SGL Payment Page of the website. Total Cost for the event is \$153.26.
3. The League is adding an additional \$20 per player to bring the prize pool to \$50 per player.
4. There is a hard deadline for signup and payment seven (7) days prior to the event, which is December 10 at 11:59pm. This time will be firm and will validate all players for the event. Cancellations with full refunds can only be done before this date.

PRIZES

1. Trophies will be given out to the overall Gross and Net winners.
2. Credit payouts to players accounts based on player participation. (25% of flight will be paid)
3. Additional prizes will be given out by raffle.
